### # Day 2

- Visit to Nusa Dua Beach: The white sand and shallow water at Nusa Dua beach is an ideal safe place for children to play in the sea, lifeguards are usually on duty. Nusa Dua means two islands, at low tide the seabed is exposed so that two islands are joined to the mainland - great for exploring



- Visit to Water Sports Center: located at Tanjung Bena, only five minutes away from Nusa Dua Resort, fifteen minutes from Kuta and more or less twenty five minutes away from Sanur. Tanjung Bena Beach has long been well known and has become the main tourist destination with its clean white sand and they can relax while other are enjoying water sports such as: Banana Boat, Parasailing, Jet Ski, Glass Bottom Boat, Scuba Diving, Snorkeling, Sport Fishing and Trawling Fishing



- Visit to GWK: (Garuda Wisnu Kencana) on the Bukit in Bali
- Visit to Uluwatu Temple: Bali's most spectacular temples located high on a cliff top at the edge of a plateau 250 feet above the waves of the Indian Ocean. Dedicated to the spirits of the sea,

the famous Pura Luhur Uluwatu temple is an architectural wonder in black coral rock, beautifully designed with spectacular views. A popular place to view the sunset



- Visit Jimbaran Beach: Gentle tides, dramatic sunsets, fine seafood restaurants. No watersports available on the beach although some may be arranged with the hotels who provide equipment and boats for snorkeling trips and sea canoe excursions. You can have dinner at the beach at your own cost

**# Day 3**  
 Breakfast at the Hotel and then visit Ubud Handy Craft Village, Maas Carvings, Batik Village, Lake Batur and Kintamani Mountain View, Tampak Siring, Ubud Market, Ubud Palace

- Visit to Ubud Handy Craft Village: Shopping some is a serious hobby; where better to practice your bargaining skills than Bali unless the Product is price-tagged, bargaining is a Fun! once you prepared to spend time and smile whilst bargaining



- Visit to Lake Batur & Kintamani Mountain: Lake Batur is the widest lake in this island. It lies down in the feet of Mount Batur and Mount Abang. At Lake Batur you can see the scenic view and feel cool atmosphere. Bangli's mountainous region centers around the spectacular volcanic crater (or caldera) of Batur. Mount Batur itself is actually just a small volcano, but its setting is in the heart of a huge crater. Adjacent to the volcano is the large crescent-shaped Batur Lake, all surrounded by the high walls of the crater rim



- Visit to Tampak Siring: The hallowed spring of Tirta Empul in Tampaksiring dates from legendary times. In popular folklore, it was made by Indra when he pierced the earth to create a spring of amerta, the elixir of immortality, with which he revived his forces that were poisoned by Mayadanawa. The waters are believed to have magic curative powers. Every year people journey from all over Bali to purify themselves in the clear pools. After leaving a small offering to the deity of the spring, men and women go either side to bathe



- Visit to Ubud Market and Palace: Puri Saren Ubud (Ubud Palace) is an Ubud Kingdom Palace with beautiful Balinese traditional houses as a residence of Ubud King. It is set in the center of Ubud Bali with traditional art market just in front of it and it is found by Ida Tjokorda Putu

Kandel who has commanded from year 1800 - 1823. This palace is an artistic cultural life center, while the traditional market is the symbol of local economics resident



- Return to Hotel and Overnight stay at the Hotel
